On behalf of the members of Killcare Surf Life Saving Club who were lucky enough to meet and work with this dedicated supporter, we extend our deepest and most sincere sympathies to Wendy and other members of Michael's family and friends.

Michael joined the Club as an Active Member in September 2000 at the age of 53. He loved Killcare, the beach, the Club and the comradeship.

Michael played an active part in the operation of the Club. He was an expert IRB Driver and was always there to support the regular Club training sessions and competitions. He was elected to the positions

of Registrar and then Club Secretary, a position he held until late 2009 when he resigned due to poor health. As Secretary, he spend many hours helping to establish the new Club House, including negotiating sub leases, arranging access security, overseeing the power and lighting arrangements. He also involved himself in the Club finances, particularly the bar and new member registration.

After the Club House was operational he continued to be "on call" when needed to check faulty alarms, adjust the afterhours lighting and deal with the Kiosk and Restaurant's issues.

In 2010 Michael received the well deserved, R. J. Tubby Trophy as the Club's most outstanding member.

Michael will be greatly missed by the many who knew him. His passing is a significant loss to the Killcare and the Surf Life Saving movement.

at SLS Central Coast Branch for you guidance, support and encouragement throughout the season.



Treasurers Report

I am pleased to announce that this financial year the club has returned to surplus and that the financial accounting process has been made even more efficient.

This year we built on our previous hard work in re-structuring the accounts to take into consideration the more complex operations of the club.

The benefits included:

- Monthly tracking of the Functions business
- · Monthly tracking of the Bar takings
- Improved tracking of revenue and expenses

The use of a bookkeeper and MYOB accounting software made it far easier to provide meaningful management accounting reports each month to the committee and this in turn allowed the committee to make timely decisions on financial issues.

It became apparent through the year that the Bar was continuously running at a loss and as a result the committee decided to implement a system of volunteer bar staff drawn from members rather than paying for staff. Also towards the end of the year, the Kiosk was invited to provide food for Sunday Sips and these two initiatives saw the Bar become profitable towards the end of the financial year.

You will notice that note 2 to the Financial Statement (please refer separate document) shows substantial differences between the 2010 and 2011 revenue and expenses. Due to this year's improved Chart of Accounts and use of MYOB, we believe that the 2011 figures are a much better breakdown. As a result we have been able to produce a monthly budget for the next year of operations to allow us to better manage the business.

Thanks to Julie Oliver's hard work, the Functions business continued to build on last year's success and finished the year profitable

and with a healthy number of bookings for the next 12 months.

Rent from the Kiosk and Randalls Restaurant were paid up to date at the end of the financial year and a special thanks to Tony Newton for helping to resolve a dispute in this regard.

For the next financial year we will also be conducting a review of the Asset Register to write down smaller items and reduce the list of depreciable items.

Revenue for the year increased by \$27,414.

Expenses for the year were also lower than last year, however we still had a number of one off new items that were purchased for the clubhouse.



This year the club championship reached a level in board & ski events never seen at Killcare. It was great to see & hope we can build on this.

Congratulations to Bryce Cameron & Natasha Martine for their wins in the Open Men's & Women's Championships. Also to Leah Fotofili for her win in the Combined Handicap Events.

With the purchase of new equipment for next year, it would be great to see our younger members involved in board & ski events at carnival level.

At Branch level we were very successful in the combined Open / Masters carnival winning 10 events, including Bryce Cameron's gold in the Tube Rescue event, plus other placing in swimming and craft events. Micky Hofer & Joel Maybury won Gold in both the Open & Masters Beach Sprint, Phil Tubby Gold in the Sprint & Flags and 140 years beach relay other team members Mark Krebs, John O'Malley & Joel Maybury. Also, our U/ 19 boat crew secured a silver medal in the Surf Boat race - it's a long time since we have secured a medal in this event. A very pleasing result in the men's U/15 beach relay, was a Gold Medal to Killcare (Scott McMaster, Luke Hater, Kayd Donkin & Tom Hagistefanis).

The State Titles were held this year at Kingscliff and a small team travelled to this carnival. We managed 2 gold & 5 Silver medals with Michaela Hofer winning the sprint & flags while silver medals came from Bryce Cameron (tube race), Leah Fotofili (beach flags) and Phil

Tubby (beach sprint & flags). The women's beach relay team, comprising Lisa Sanasi, Micky Hofer, Leah Fotofili & Laura Washington finished a close second behind Queenscliff. Other really good results were recorded in individual events by Lisa Sanasi, Julian Hofer, Laura Washington & Leah Fotofili.

The Australian Titles were held at Kurrawa Beach Qld and we stayed at Broadbeach which was ideal for our preparation. A team of 11 members came home with 2 gold, 4 silver and a bronze.

Phil Tubby won the beach flags his first individual medal gained at an Australian Titles. Also Joel Maybury retained his over 35 years title in the beach sprint. Silver medals were won by Joel Maybury (beach flags), Micky Hofer (beach sprint), Men's 170 years beach relay (Moses Fotofili, Phil & Colin Tubby, Joel Maybury), Women's 140 years beach relay (Tegan Spackman, Leah Fotofili, Micky Hofer & Laura Washington) and a Bronze medal to Colin Tubby in the Beach Flags.

Next year the World Championships will be held in Adelaide and with the Branch, State & Aussies it will be a very long season.

These results could not be gained without the full support of the Committee & Members whom at all times were vey supporting.



The senior paddlers would love you to approach them next season for tips and encouragement.

The training boards and skis are for member use and it is for security reasons that access to this equipment is restricted at times. If anyone is keen to compete next season, or just improve their board or ski skills, please approach the board and ski officer or any member of the committee to try and organise suitable access and supervision of themselves and the equipment. If using the equipment whilst on the beach of a weekend, let the

patrol captain know you are in the water.

Thank you to all those members in particular the Patrol Captains that helped with keeping an eye on the boards and skis this season, encouraging all people that used the equipment to wash them down before storing and assisted with storage of these fragile and expensive items on the racks. We had less repairs to the boards required this season which is a credit to the handling skills of members and the training that has been provided by some of the senior members to the nippers during the week and on Sundays.

I continue to encourage members and younger member's parents and siblings to ensure anyone using a board or ski on the beach to return it rinsed off to a rack in the storage shed. Remember to carry not drag the boards to increase their longevity.
