

Choose Your Patrols

Couldn't be easier. Tap 'Select Patrols' and you'll see a list of all the patrol dates. With the exception of periods one and five, all the patrols are half days. If you want to do all day, just put yourself on the am and pm patrols.



Find your date and tap Join. It will come up with a list of all the positions you're qualified for and you can untick any except Bronze.



Tap the Join button, and you are on.



Something came up? No sweat, find the date, tap the button and you'll be off that one.

Your Patrols

Once you've put yourself on, on the dashboard and under Your Patrols you'll see all your dates and you can download an iCal file that you can import into your favourite calendar app.


How Many Patrols Do I Have To Do?

After your patrol, tap Kudos in the left hand menu.




Just tick a box for each point you want to award, then click the button to save it.

You're now in charge.






Start at http://Killcare.FlexiPatrol.au and enter your SLSA Member Number.

Put it in once, and that browser will remember it.

There are no passwords, the system will send you a verification code which you enter, and you're in.

If you can use email please do, but SMS is available too.

Once you're in, tap the hamburger menu (the three bars) on the top right.

Your Availability

You have a few options to configure all so we don't bother you.


First up, let us know if you might be available for last minute call ups. No obligation, it just lets us know if we should ask.

Got a holiday planned? Easy peasy. Select the date span you're away and save. Have a great trip.




Your Crew

There are no set teams but we know there are people you like hanging out with. We got you.

Tap on Your Crew on the left hand menu.

On the right, you start typing a name, select it when it comes up and tap the button to confirm.



They'll get an invitation and assuming they accept it, they'll be in your crew! When you put down for a patrol, they'll be notified and vice versa so you can jump on the same one.
